TRADITIONAL CLUB

This is the most common Kiwanis club type: It meets 2-4 times each month, performs service to the community in locally relevant ways, and appeals to members for a wide range of reasons.

3-2-1 CLUB

"3-2-1" club represents three hours of service, two hours of social activity, and a one-hour meeting each month. These clubs reflect member's desire to meet less and serve more.

INTERNET CLUB

Members meet via online platforms. The club varies in their inclusion of traditional components of a Kiwanis club meeting, and opportunities to meet up in person for service projects.

YOUNG PROFESSIONALS CLUB

A Young Professional club reflects the lifestyle and behavioral trends of younger people earlier in their careers. The clubs approach to meetings, service and social activities reflects the attitudes of its members.
